If paying credit card, please email your signed Letter of Acceptance to dcol-admissions@deakin.edu.au, together with a copy of your passport or evidence of citizenship (if not yet provided), and proof of payment.

What happens if I do not attend Enrolment Day?

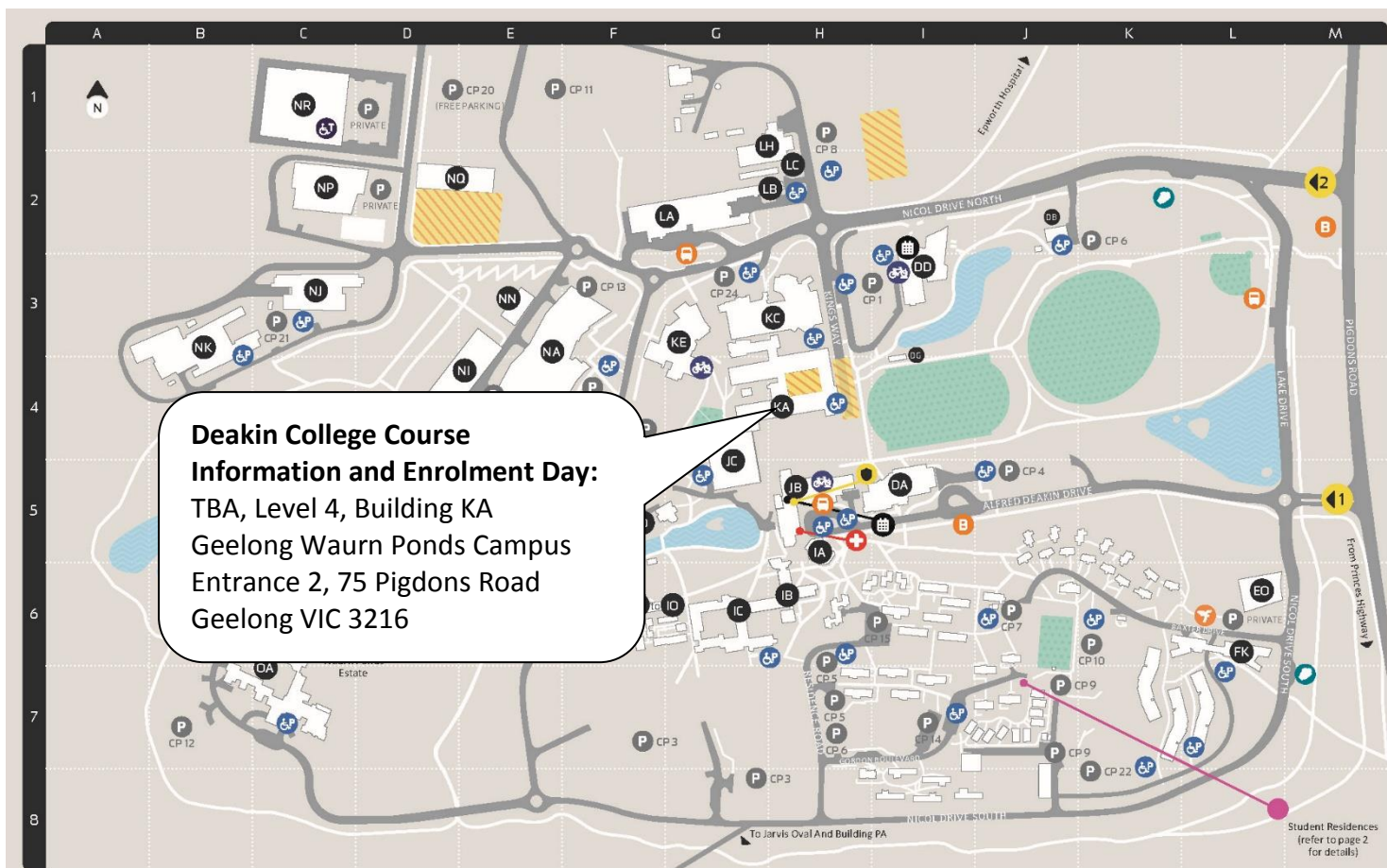
If you are not able to attend Enrolment Day, please contact Deakin College on 03 9244 5600 to receive information about late enrolment.

Bus
