What happens if I do not attend Orientation and Enrolment Day?

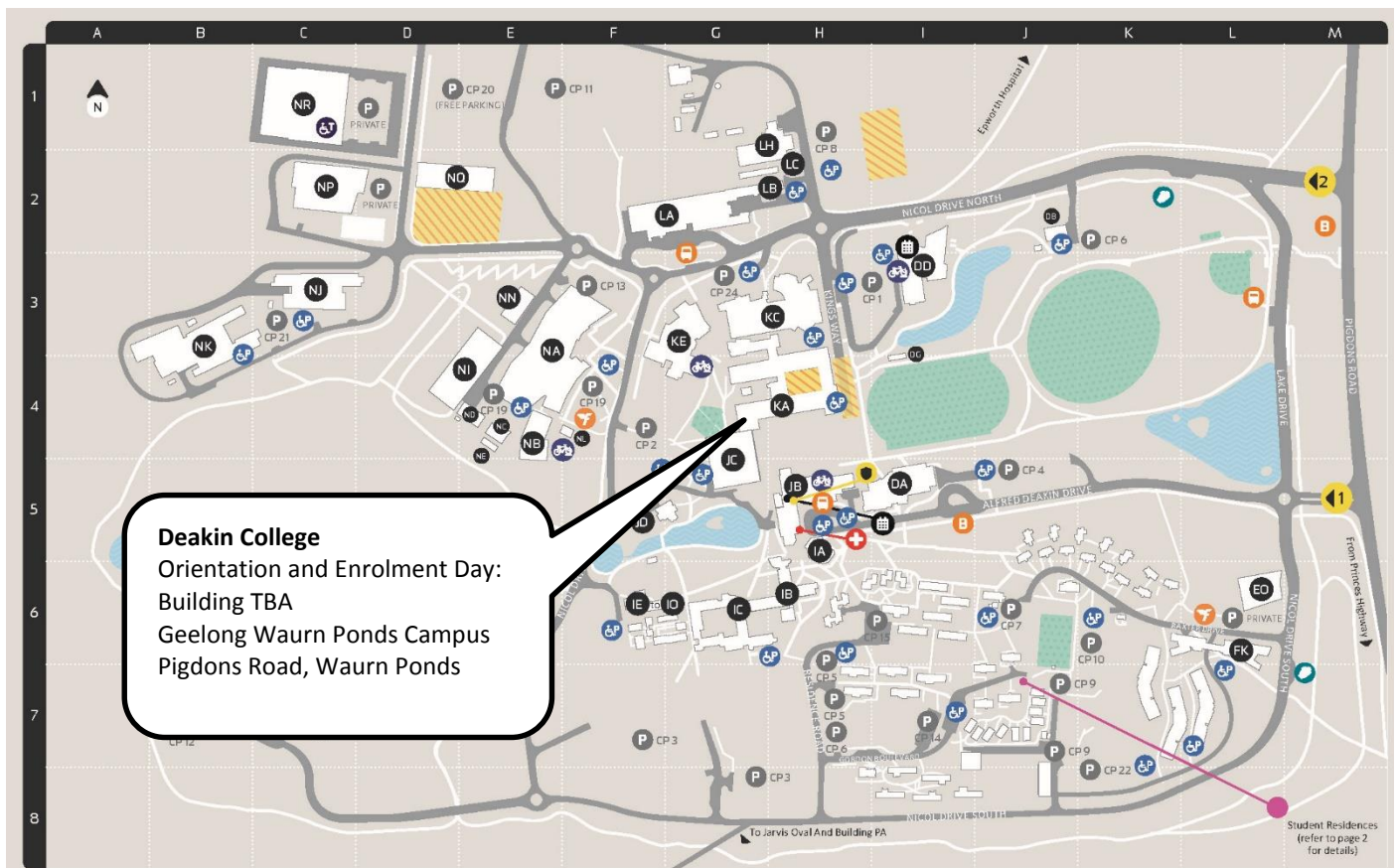
If you do not attend Orientation and Enrolment Day, you may miss out on the units and classes that you wish to take during that trimester.

Bus

Bus 18 Deakin Direct is an express bus service that runs from the Geelong Train Station only during Deakin Trimesters into the centre of the Waurn Ponds campus. For other bus services, please refer to the Geelong Bus timetables at: cdcvictoria.com.au/timetables/geelong.

Train

V/Line trains operate regularly between Southern Cross Station in Melbourne, and Geelong. The campus is a 30 minute trip by car or bus from central Geelong train station. The V/Line timetable is available at ptv.vic.gov.au.

Car

You can drive from Melbourne city to Geelong via the West Gate, Princes freeways & Geelong Bypass.

From Melbourne Airport, you can go via the Western Ring Road and the Geelong Bypass. Daily permit parking is available at CP 3 and CP 8, or free parking is available at CP 20. Please have coins available for the parking meter. Please allow time to find a parking space and to walk to Deakin College or venue indicated.
